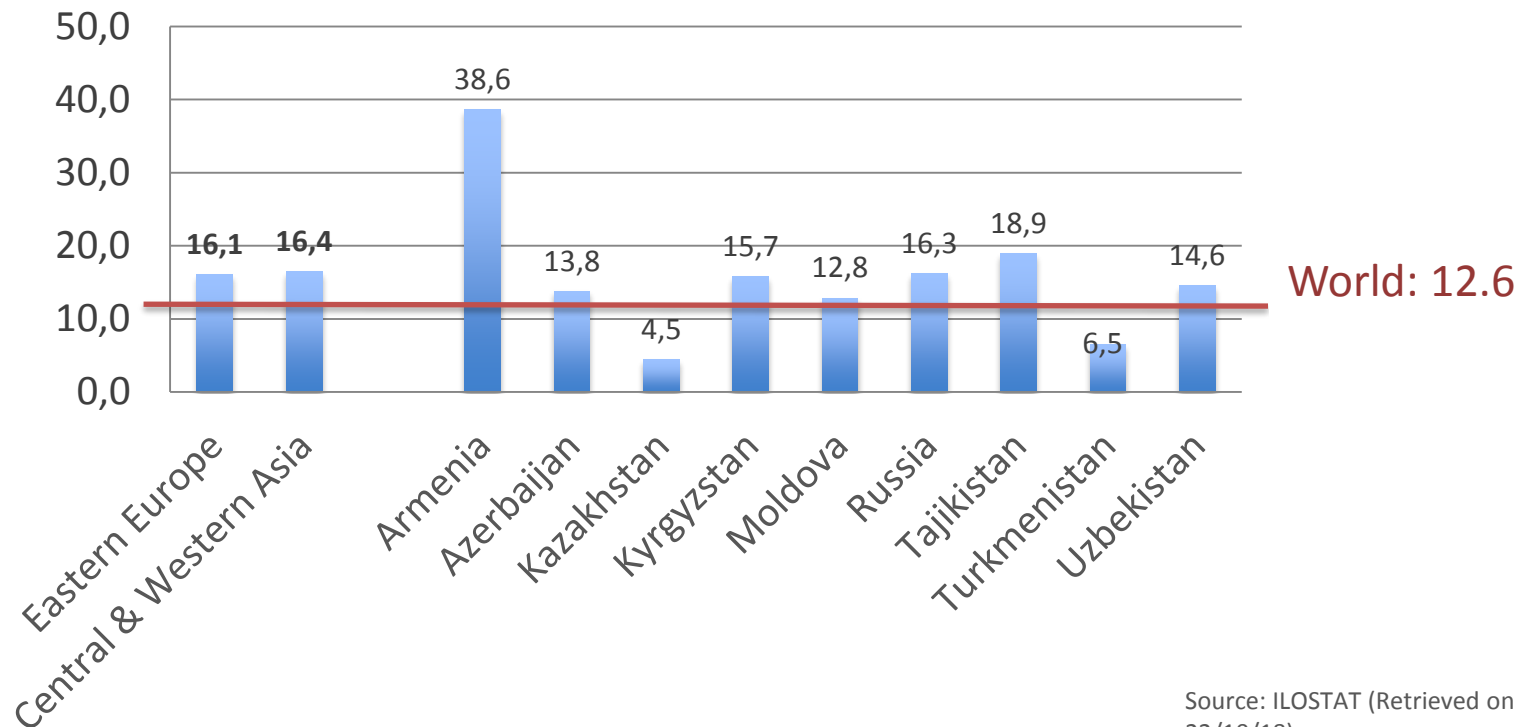

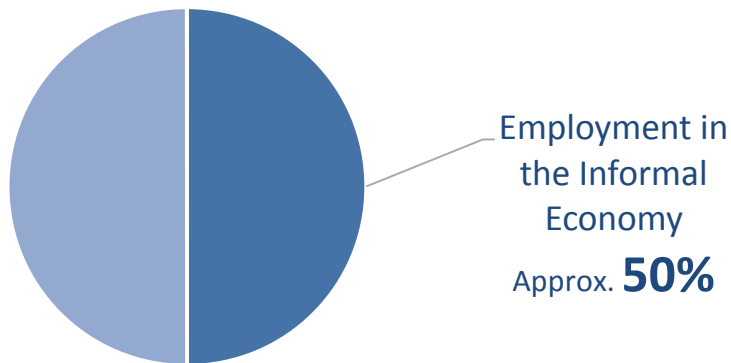
Youth Unemployment Rate

ILO modelled estimates (% , 2017)



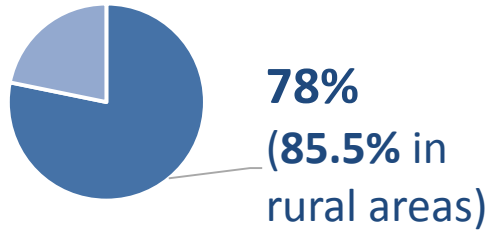
“Quality of work”: Underemployment in the CIS

- Around half of total youth employment in the CIS: In the **informal economy**



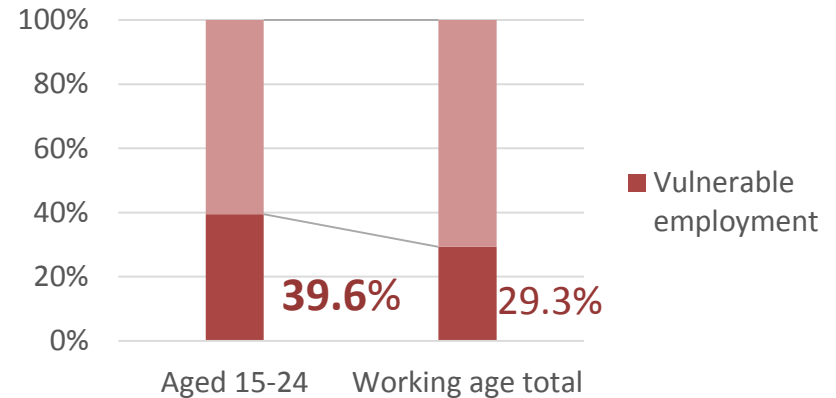

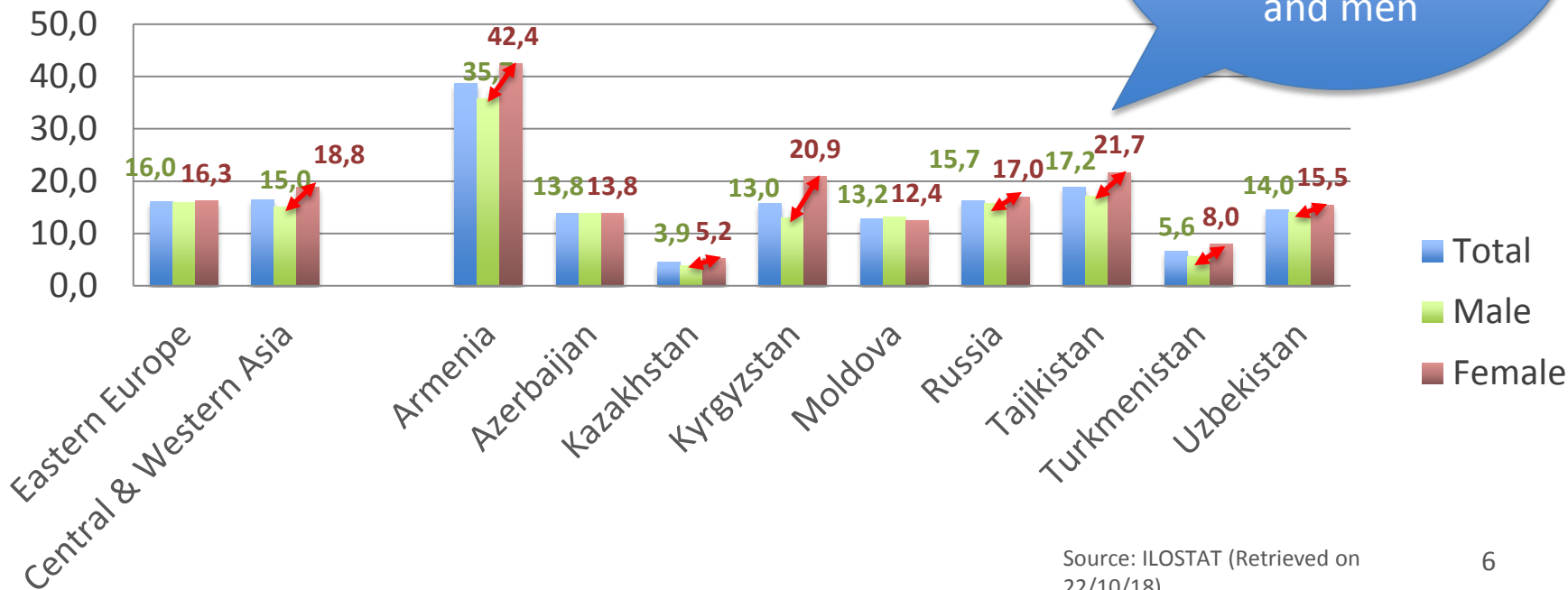

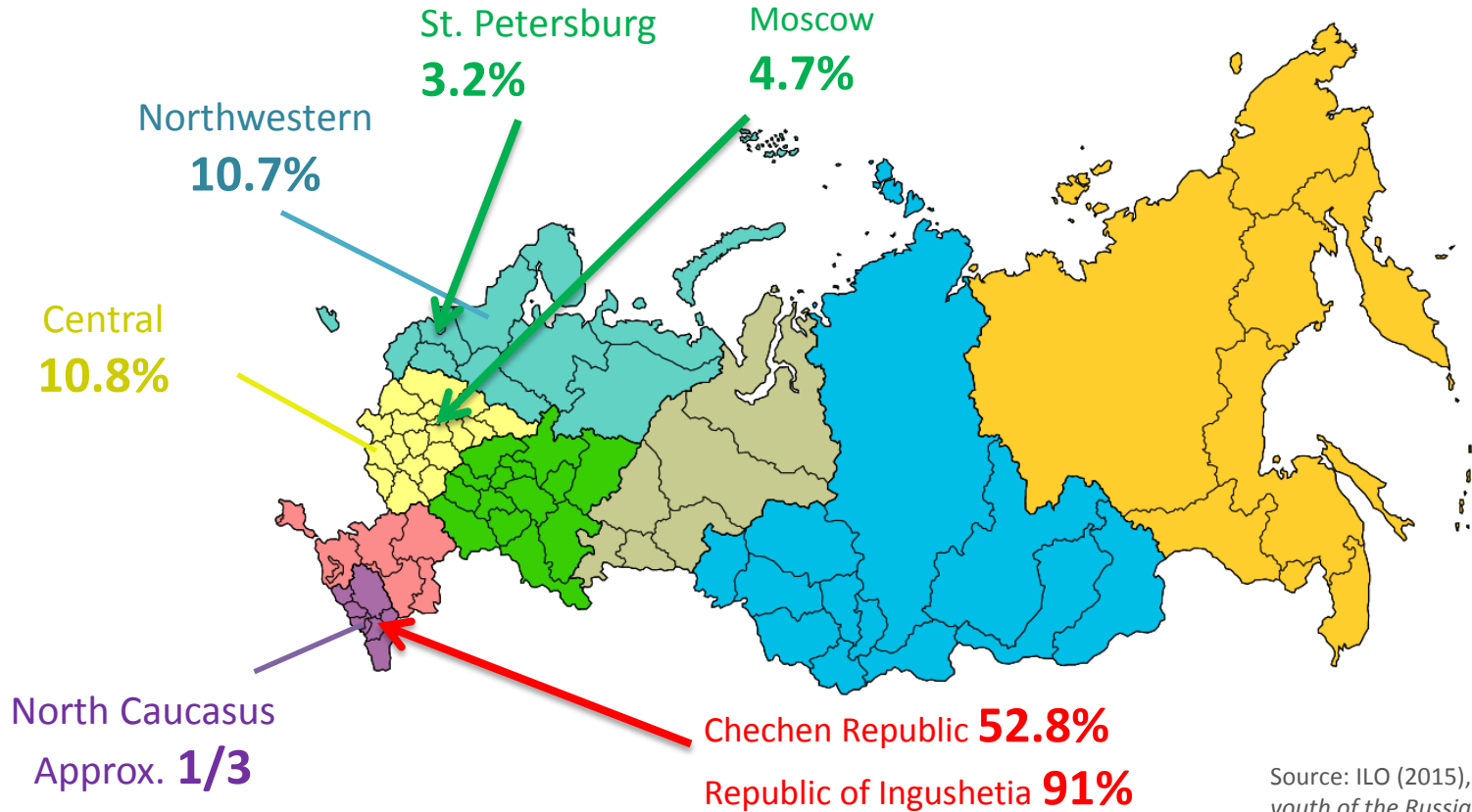
Perceptions of the traditional roles of women and men

Youth Unemployment Rate

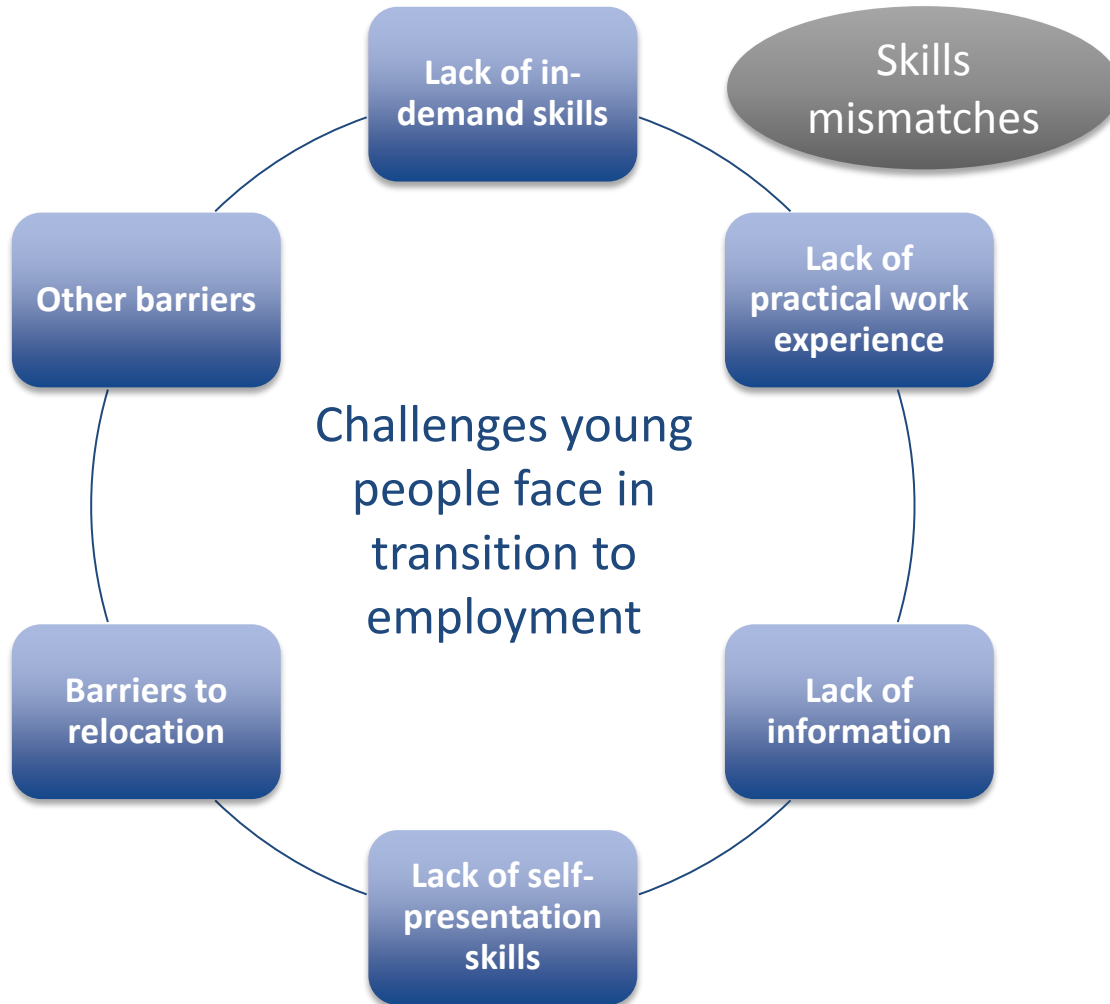
ILO modelled estimates (% , 2017)

“Partnership for Youth Employment in the CIS (YEP-CIS)”



- Geographical areas covered
 - Regional level:
 - CIS countries + Georgia
 - Country level:
 - (Phase I) Russia, Kazakhstan, Azerbaijan
 - (Phase II) Russia, Kazakhstan, Azerbaijan + Uzbekistan
 - Sub-national level:
 - (Phase I) Khanty-Mansy Autonomous Region, Perm Territory, the Republic of Kalmykia
 - (Phase II) Astrakhan Region, Kaliningrad Region, the Republic of Komi

- Time frame:
 - (Phase I) January 2013 – February 2018
 - (Phase II) January 2018 – 31 December 2022
- Donor: LUKOIL
- Budget: USD 6 million
- Activities at regional, national, and sub-national levels
